CHECKLIST

- DNA-test for mother and child – ordered and paid to Oslo University Hospital in Norway (OUS)**

The following documentation must be provided for each child applying for a Norwegian national identity number before given an appointment:

- Original Birth certificate showing the mother and father's name and nationality and English translation, legalized by Sudan MFA.
- Original Marriage certificate and English translation, legalized by Sudan MFA.
- Civil status of the mother when the child was born.
- Mothers' and Fathers' valid passport
 - if one of the parents are in Norway, the parent must give his/her consent at the police station. The consent (fullmakt) and a copy of the fathers passport must be sent to the embassy email address: consular.khartoum@mfa.no from the police station.
- The consent (Fullmakt) sent from the Police in Norway.
- If the child is also a citizen of another country, it is requested that documentation for this citizenship be attached, possibly in the form of a copy of a passport and/or citizenship certificate and, if possible, a description of how and when this citizenship was granted.
- Proof of paid fees (passport, stamping, paternity acknowledgment)
- two recent color photos of the child on white background. High quality, in focus. Not older than 3 months, ears must be visible, the eyes must be open, and the mouth closed.

IF coming to an appointment and documents are missing. Application will not be accepted, and the applicant will not be prioritised for the next appointment.
