

Passport application checklist (over 18)

The Norwegian Embassy in London

All documentation must be prepared before your appointment. See more on our website [Norway in the United Kingdom](#)

Information in the passport system is taken directly from the [National Population Register](#) (Folkeregisteret) and must be up to date before you can be issued a passport. This includes name, place of birth/country of birth, and citizenship. **Please ensure your information is up to date [here](#) or by contacting [Skatteetaten](#).**

Documentation required for adults (18 and over)

- Application form** completed and printed before the appointment.
- Passport** (valid or expired) or Norwegian ID-card.
 - You cannot renew your passport if you do not present your old passport. If your passport expired more than 3 months ago you must bring other valid government-issued photo ID or your birth certificate.
 - Bring also passports from other countries of which you are a citizen.
- If applicable, a letter from UDI confirming you have **retained your Norwegian citizenship (bibehold)**.
- If applicable, a letter from UDI confirming you have **reclaimed your Norwegian citizenship (gjenerverv)**.
- Proof of legal residency in the UK**
Bring one of the following:
 - EUSS '[share code](#)' to prove your status (EU Settlement Scheme)
 - Valid UK visa
 - Valid UK passport
- Credit or debit card (not American Express)** to pay the application fee. Cash payments are not accepted.

When applying for a passport, the embassy must ensure that all requirements are met and that there are no legal obstructions to issuing a passport. This means that some applications can entail longer processing times.
