
Norway's economic contribution to **NEBRASKA**

The earliest Norwegian settlement in Nebraska traces back to around 1857 and was established in Dixon County. Throughout Nebraska, various locations bore post offices with names such as Elling, Scandia, Scandinavia, Olnes, and Hoffland—believed to have been named in after of Norwegian immigrants.
