

The town of Norway in Orangeburg County, South Carolina is so named because the railroad company that reached the area in 1891 was pursuing a Scandinavian theme for its new line. Nearby, the communities of Sweden and Finland were founded by the company along the same line and an existing depot was renamed to Denmark.
