

## DOCUMENT CHECKLIST SCHENGEN VISA TO NORWAY

## PERSONS WHO ARE TRAVELLING WITH, OR VISITING, A FAMILY MEMBER WHO IS AN EU/EEA NATIONAL

The documents must be provided in:

- A4 format only. No staples or pins. If not specified otherwise, copies are accepted.
- No supporting documents will be returned.

## I. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

<b>Original passport</b> issued in the last 10 years and valid for min. 3 months after the		
intended travel & containing at least two blank pages.		
One <b>photo</b> no older than six months, not edited ( <u>requirements</u> )		
A signed print out of the Harmonised application form from the UDI online		
application portal		
MINORS UNDER 18 YEARS		
All minors (children under 18 years): birth certificate		
<ul> <li>For minors travelling alone or with only one parent:</li> <li>a) original passports of both parents, or certified copy of the biodata page of the passports; b) proof of consent of parental authority or legal guardian; and c) British school certificate.</li> </ul>		
In the case of sole custody, the following documents must be submitted: a) birth certificate mentioning one parent; b) death certificate of absent parent; or c) court ruling		
OPTIONAL		
If you want another person to represent you during the case process, you must give the		
person a <u>power of attorney</u>		

## II. DOCUMENTS DEPENDING ON THE PURPOSE OF YOUR VISIT

Documents which shows that you are travelling with, or visiting a family member who is a EU/EEA national.

You must hand in documents which tighter show that:

1) The person you are travelling with or visiting is:

- citizen of another EU/EEA country than Norway who is moving to, living in or visiting Norway, **or**
- a Norwegian citizen who is living in another EU/EEA country, or has lived there on a permanent basis and is moving back to Norway **and**
- 2) you are a close family member of this person (spouse/partner/cohabitant/child who is under the age of 21/ child who is over the age of 21 and is supported financially by the parent / parent who is supported financially by their child), and
- 3) you will be travelling with this person to Norway, or join him or her in Norway.

Examples of documents you may hand in to document this, depending on your situation - Documents proving an EU/EU citizen is the reference person: for example: passport or residence card of the EU/EAA citizen
<ul> <li>documentation of proof of family relationship for example: marriage certificate, birth certificate, bank statement that shows that you are supported financially by the EU/EEA national</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Documents showing you will be travelling or visiting the EU/EEA national: for example: flight tickets showing you will be travelling together or documentation which shows the EU/EEA national lives in Norway already.</li> </ul>
