



Request for appointment for Norwegian national identity number and first-time issue of passport at the Royal Norwegian Embassy in Tehran

FOR CHILDREN BORN IN AFGHANISTAN OR IRAQ

General information

You need to apply for a Norwegian identity number at the same time as you are applying for the Norwegian passport.

Norwegian citizens have the right to receive a Norwegian passport. If you do not already have a Norwegian national identity number, the embassy will request one from the National Population Registry on your behalf before issuing the passport. To get a national identity number, it is important to bring the correct documentation when going to the Embassy.

About declaration of paternity If the marriage is not registered in the Norwegian National Population Register, the father should also declare paternity for the child. If the father is accompanying the mother to the embassy, the declaration of paternity can be completed at the embassy. If the father is in Norway, he must go to Skatteetaten to fill in a declaration of paternity and ask Skatteetaten to send the declaration of paternity to the embassy in Tehran. About DNA-test

The child's parents must arrange the DNA analysis themselves before attending the appointment. During the appointment at the embassy, samples for a DNA test will be taken of the mother and child.

You must order and pay for the DNA test. The parents must provide the test number to the embassy when applying for the child's passport and national identity number.

Consent

Parents must give their consent for passports issued to a child under the age of 18. If parents have joint custody, both parents must consent to the passport application. At least one of them must accompany the child to the appointment. Consent can only be given through in-person attendance at a Norwegian passport authority. You must bring valid ID, such as your passport or national ID card.

Parents do not have to attend the embassy or police station at the same time to give consent. This can be done at different times and at different embassies, consulates or police stations in Norway.

However, consent must have been received from both parents **before or during the passport appointment for the minor**.

Fees

The passport fee must be paid in **cash** at the embassy at the time of your appointment:

- **EUR 70** for children below the age of 16.
- **EUR 120** for children above the age of 16.

Important information

- Please remember to bring passports of both parents, or, if not applicable, another form of authorised ID document to the appointment. Please also bring original ID documents for the child.
- You must bring all required documents, as stated in the instructions from the Norwegian Tax Authority (Skatteetaten).
- Before applying for a passport and national identity number for the child, paternity must be established.
