Outcomes	<p>Outcome 1: Women and youth are strategically linked to decision making process and access to meaningful and equitable representation in post-conflict governance structure at various levels to enable youth and women voices to be reflected in peacebuilding and reconciliation through engagement in the implementation and monitoring of peace agreement.</p> <p>Outcome 2: Security and stabilization of communities affected by conflict in Blue Nile State are improved through utilization of effective conflict management mechanisms, peace dividends, quality basic services accessible to all, and support to peace infrastructures and peaceful coexistence and social cohesion.</p> <p>Outcome 3: IDPs and Vulnerable families (women and youth in particular), in Er-Roseiris, Ed-Damazine, Geisan and El Kurmuk localities, progressively increased self-reliance, and significantly increased their income by increased access to skills, productive assets (including secured land tenure), and improved employment opportunity.</p>
