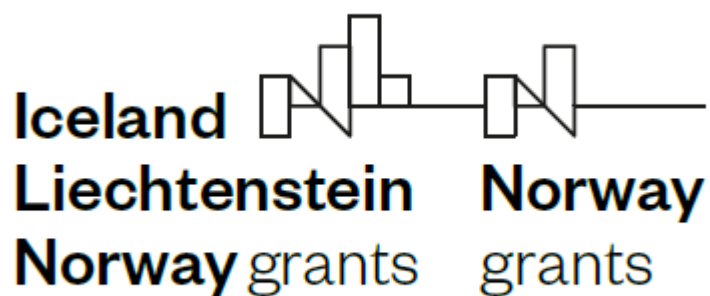

5 INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK IN THE ASYLUM AND MIGRATION SECTOR – €12.3 million

The program aimed to ensure the existence of a functioning national migration management system in Greece that safeguards the right to seek asylum and gives special attention to the situation for vulnerable groups of asylum seekers, including unaccompanied asylum seeking children.
