

Application for Norwegian personal number – check-list

The personal number is a five-digit number issued by Norwegian Tax Authorities. **This number is required in order to issue and renew a Norwegian passport.**

Minors under the age of 12 are **required** to file an application for passport together with the personal number application.

Please check each bullet below to confirm the required documents you have submitted:

To obtain a personal number, you must include the following:

- Application
- Original or notarized copy of the child's birth certificate.
- If applicable, original or notarized copy of the child's American passport
- Original or notarized copies of **both** parents' passports.
- Original or notarized copy/copies of the US Permanent Resident Card or US Visa of the Norwegian parent/parents.
- If the child's parents are married at the time of the child's birth:
 - Please enclose original or notarized copy of marriage licence
- If the child's parents are **not** married at the time of the child's birth:
 - Please file a declaration of paternity in the state where the child was born and attach with application, or present us with a court order declaring the paternity.
- IF applicant is over the age of 18:
 - If applicable, bring your Norwegian passport
 - Original or notarized copy of American passport
- 22 years old or older:
 - If you are born into a dual citizenship, please enclose a letter of retention of your Norwegian citizenship.

Processing time varies but normally it takes 6-8 weeks.

Application with the enclosed documents must be submitted in person at any of our honorary consulates or with the Consulate General in San Francisco. If applicant is over the age of 12, application to be mailed to the Consulate General.
