Information in the passport system is taken directly from the <u>National Population Register</u> (Folkeregisteret). This includes name, place of birth/country of birth, and citizenship(s). Please ensure that the Norwegian parent(s)'s information is up to date on <u>this link</u> or by contacting <u>Skatteetaten</u>.

We kindly request that you style your child's hair in a manner that allows ears and eyebrows to be clearly visible. In case it is not possible to capture a passport photo that fulfils the Norwegian Police's <u>criteria</u> during your appointment, you will be required to come back to the Embassy after the national identity number has been issued for the passport photo. In this case, you will be asked to provide a photo of your child at your appointment for identification purposes.
