2.	CONSENT FORM
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Parents **MUST** give their written consent for passports to be issued to a child under the age of 18.

At least one of the parents must accompany the child to the appointment **AND** produce valid passports for both parents as well as the child. If only one parent is accompanying the child, the other must have signed the consent form in advance.

If one of the parents resides or is currently outside the UK, they must meet in person at a police station in Norway or at a Norwegian embassy to give their consent.

If you have sole parental responsibility for the child, this must be registered in the Norwegian Population Registry (Folkeregisteret). See more information on our website:
