

Personal Number Application Checklist

The Norwegian Embassy in London

All documentation must be prepared before your appointment. All forms can be found on our [website](#). Please consult our website for more information if you have any questions.

Documentation required for minors (under 18).

- Visit this link first: www.skatteetaten.no
- Original **birth certificate**
 - If the birth certificate is not from Norway or the UK, it must be legalised with an apostille
- If the minor is a dual citizen, their **other passport** (if they have one)
- 2 passport-sized photos**
- Both parents' original and valid passports**
- If applicable, also bring proof of **Retention of Citizenship** for the Norwegian parent(s).

- Married couples must register their marriage with the Norwegian Tax Administration in Norway themselves **before** applying for a personal number for their child. Visit www.skatteetaten.no for more information.
- If the child was born before **01.09.2006** and the Norwegian father was not married to the foreign mother at the time of birth, please contact UDI for guidance.
- If the parents are not married/were not married at the time of the child's birth, they may have to establish paternity or co-maternity in Norway **prior** to applying for a personal number for their child. Please see the following link to see if this applies to you: www.nav.no

In special cases

- Death certificate (legalised with an apostille), if either parent is deceased
- Court order/specific issue order (signed and legalised with an apostille), if parental responsibility differs from that listed on the birth certificate/in the National Population Register (Folkeregisteret). Please see more information on our [website](#).
- Recognition of adoption from Bufdir/Bufetat, if the child is adopted

Documentation required for adults (18 and over).

- Valid and original passport**
 - Original **birth certificate**
 - Proof of your Norwegian citizenship**
 - E.g. your Norwegian parent's passport or personal number, confirmation from UDI that you are a Norwegian citizen
- If you were born before **01.09.2006** and your Norwegian father was not married to your foreign mother at the time of birth, please contact [UDI](#) for guidance
- If applicable, confirmation that you have **retained your Norwegian citizenship**
 - If applicable, documentation to prove that you are exempt from retention of citizenship ([Riksborgerlova 1950 § 8](#))

Please note that your application cannot be processed if you fail to provide the documentation requested on this list.
