On the occasion of the 75th anniversary of the Council of Europe, the five Permanent Representations of the Nordic countries to the Council of Europe have the pleasure of inviting you to participate in a series of three events (2024 – 2025) around the issue of men, boys and gender equality. The project is supported and funded by the Nordic Council of Ministers.
