

**Please note that the general requirements here need to be complied with before the requirements below are taken into consideration.**

**Specific requirements for visits by children (under 18 year) all categories**

- Original and copy of birth certificate
- Copy of both parents ID-cards and passports, if applicable (all pages containing any type of information)
- Written consent letter with phone and email contacts from both parents if the child is travelling alone, or from the parent that is not accompanying the child when travelling
- If a parent has sole custody of the child, this must be documented by providing an order from the Children's Court stating this
- If either one of the parents is absent or deceased this must be supported by the information on the birth certificate or a death certificate when applicable
- If the legal guardian is someone else apart from the biological parent as stated in the birth certificate a custody order must be submitted proving the legal guardianship
- A letter from school containing the child's name, name of parents, grade, number of years at school, leave days granted, contact details, date and name of school representative
- If the child is travelling with a group, please submit a complete list of names of all group members travelling and name of person in charge of the group
- Children travelling in a group must have clearance from the relevant Authority:
- High school students need clearance by the Ministry of Education
- Primary school/elementary school pupils need clearance by the Ministry of Education and Children Services Department
  
- An interview may be required at the Embassy or by phone
- You may be asked to provide further information or documentary evidence in addition to the above guidelines
