FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT
BETWEEN
UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (UNDP)
AND
THE NORWEGIAN MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS

Reference is made to the Cost Sharing Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") dated 1st December 2016 and signed between the UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (UNDP) and the NORWEGIAN MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MFA) with respect to the National Registration Identification System, Project No. 00100113. As per the Article 22 of the Agreement, it may be modified through an exchange of letters between MFA and UNDP. To this effect, the letters exchanged shall become an integral part of the agreement.

Therefore, the two Parties hereby agree on the following:

WHEREAS the donor and UNDP now wish to amend the said agreement in order to ensure additional contribution for improving the living and working conditions of the registration teams involved in the mass registration;

WHEREAS such Amendment will result in an increase of 4,225,000 NOK making this amended Agreement total 22,225,000.00 NOK;


NEVERTHELESS, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement, except as amended herein, shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect.


