Please note, the consulate does not accept card payment.</li> </ul>
If you are not able to pick up your new passport at the consulate, you must bring  a pre-paid, self-addressed envelope from the Postal Service, Fedex or UPS (express or priority w/tracking of your choosing), and  a waiver for delivery of passport by mail (Declaration of Waiver and Hold Harmless form)
☐ If you are a dual citizen, you must also present your <b>US passport</b> . ☐ If applicable, a <b>letter from UDI</b> confirming your retention of Norwegian citizenship must accompany your application.
Documentation required for minors (under 18)
☐ The <b>same documentation as for adults</b> (see above), and ☐ <b>Consent form</b> signed by both parents. If only one parent is accompanying the minor to the appointment, the signature of the absent parent on the consent form <b>must</b> be notarized, and ☐ <b>Poth parents</b> (passports)
☐ <b>Both parents' passports</b> ☐ Minors under the age of 12 must also bring <b>two passport-size photos</b> . Glasses must be removed, the eyes must be open and the mouth closed. The ears must be visible. The photo should be of good quality, in colour, taken against a light background, not older than 3 months, approx. 36x47mm.
