Clarifications regarding residence permit for work and work visa

According to the Norwegian Immigration Act and regulations everyone who intends to work in Norway, paid or unpaid, needs a residence permit for work, even though the work is for one day. Newly updated circular clarifies that application for residence permit for work functions as the absolute main rule and not application for business visa.
